




### LAST WEEK WE PUBLISHED a pancake and

Additionally, the club will qualify to solicit funds on Facebook and Amazon among others.

Larry is going to work with CUSD officials to transfer Key Club funds to our account. Jerry Huo of Mission Viejo High reports his club was preparing for its first meeting and a new member rush.
