Pal are the forms of payment. Items will be shipped to your home or other address you provide. If you need assistance, don't hesitate to contact me and I will talk to you through the process.


Naturally, with change comes -- well -- change. By ordering directly online you will have access to more items than we were able to offer in previous years. Also, there will be a shipping charge per below:

- -VOTED NOT to bill for dues once a year; will stay with current monthly pro-rated plan.


—AGREED to send \$200 to South County Outreach this year instead of delivering turkeys as in the past. Members can go online to make individual donations to SCO.
